Woodwork Classes

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Do I have to have prior experience to begin Woodwork classes?**
No prior woodworking experience is necessary, as we start you off right from the basics and guide you every step of the way.
- 2. Do I need to wear anything special?**
We will require you to wear enclosed footwear; steel capped boots if you have them otherwise sandals/runners will be fine. We will supply you with any other safety equipment required.
- 3. How big are the class sizes?**
The class sizes are kept small – no more than 6 in a class so that you get personalized and individual attention.
- 4. Do you have many females in the class?**
Yes, we do, they are most welcome and thoroughly enjoy developing new skills. Under the expert guidance of Stuart or David.
- 5. Are materials covered in the cost of the course?**
All materials required for the initial beginner's course are covered within the course fee. After the initial course, students cover the cost of the timber they require to make a specific project, all other costs including glue, sandpaper, use of machines is covered in the course fees.
- 6. How do I pay for classes?**
You can pay for classes by direct deposit, payment of cash or cheque before commencement of classes. It is a requirement that your full Course Fee is paid upfront before the course commences. Once payment has been processed you will be issued with a tax invoice for claim purposes.



7. What happens if I miss a class due to illness?

If in the unfortunate event that you are sick we will endeavor to offer you a makeup class at a mutually agreeable date.

8. Are Course Fees refundable?

No, once fees are paid they are deemed nonrefundable.

9. Do you offer food /drink?

We offer tea, coffee /water and biscuits, students often have a quick break during our classes and enjoy a cuppa with fellow students.

10. After I finish the beginner's course what happens next?

After you finish the initial beginner's course you will have completed your custom made chopping board. Most of our course participants then choose to re-enroll for an intermediate course where they can choose a woodwork project of your liking and work within classes to complete this.
